- **Workflow Engine:** The engine can execute, manage, and optimize complex processes defined in industry standard Business Process Modeling Notation (BPMN). Each process becomes a conversation thread, along with built-in commenting, discussion topics and real-time chat. The engine can handle millions of business processes running at the same time and it is even compact enough to be embedded in OEM solutions if desired.
- **Artificial Intelligence:** DXP BPMS is designed to connect and leverage AI services from other software vendors such as Google Cloud, AWS, and Azure. You can use AI to augment your processes with more intelligent features such as text translations, image recognition, content classification, and much more. All those can be done through pluggable components including process actions, process agents, and service connectors.
- **Document Repository:** The built-in document repository is a file-based repository that can store anything, from documents, data records and files to whatever you need to associate with the process once it is started. For more advanced usages, you can switch it to use a more powerful

document management system such as Alfresco, which not only stores the document, but offers capabilities to convert documents to other formats and allows full text search across all the documents.

- **Case Management:** Predefined processes allow tight control when the process is known in advance. Case management, on the other hand, deals with processes that can not be defined before starting. Knowledge workers can direct each case according to their unique specifics. Case management goes beyond predefined processes, to support ad-hoc and define-as-you-go processes needed by knowledge workers.
- **Industry-standard Integrations:** DXP BPMS was built with integration in mind. Send events and messages to all types of devices. Make calls to web services, cloud services and other Application Program Interfaces (APIs). In turn, those external programs can make calls into DXP BPMS through a set of predefined REST APIs.
